1. Overdrive and Audible

Everyone knows about the reading apps, such as iBooks, the Nook and Kindle, but I was pleasantly surprised recently to find that I can borrow digital library books from $my\ local\ library\ using\ the\ \underline{Overdrive\ app}.\ Free,\ current\ books-how\ great\ is\ that!$ Just install the Overdrive app and find your local library in the list of participating libraries, then check out books using your library card.

Audible is an app that lets you check out audio library books - so great to listen to when you're walking on the treadmill and bored out of your mind.

2. Mapquest

I got a Garmin GPS for Christmas this year and that device has traveled all over the U.S. with us. But when I went on a girlfriends getaway recently, the GPS let us down because a resort we were visiting had a name change, which resulted in the name of the access road also changing. My SIL went on her cell phone and accessed the MapQuest app, which sent us directly to the resort. It even gave us audio

instructions. This app is just as good as a GPS, the only disadvantage is that the maps are a little hard to read on your iPhone since they're kind of small.


3. Grocery Gadget
